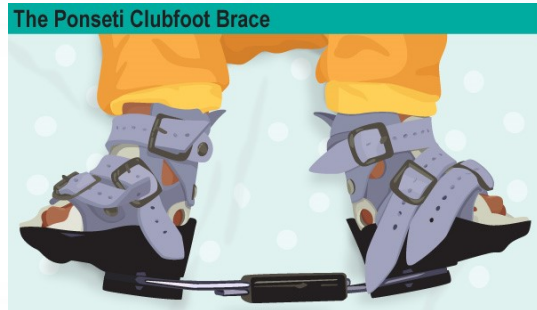
Our Speaker

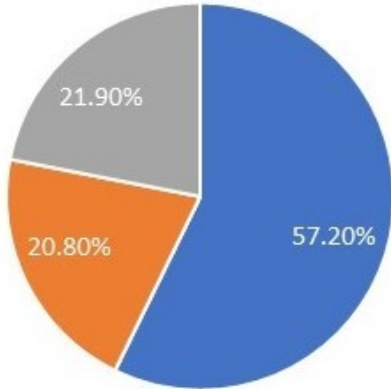
