The 4-Way Test

It was created by Rotarian Herbert Taylor in 1932, when he was asked to take charge of a large company, which was facing bankruptcy.

He drew up a 24-word code of ethics for all the employees to follow in the company, and their professional lives. The 4-Way Test became the guide for sales, production, advertising and all relations with dealers and customers. ***The survival of the company was credited to this simple philosophy.***

The 4-Way Test was adopted by Rotary in 1943 and has been translated into more than 100 languages.
