The Rotary Foundation's Beginning

In 1917, RI President Arch Klumph told the delegates to the Atlanta Convention that "It seems eminently proper that we should accept endowments for the purpose of doing good in the world."

A year later the Rotary Endowment Foundation, as it was first labelled, received its first contribution from the Rotary Club of Kansas City.

A decade later, the Rotary Foundation was formally established at the 1928 Minneapolis Convention.

From those humble beginnings, the Rotary Foundation is now receiving more than \$300 million each year for educational and humanitarian work around the world and in our district.
